This instruction establishes requirements for locally manufactured equipment with no technical data or AFOSH Standard directing inspections. It implements AFPD 21-1, *Managing Aerospace Equipment Maintenance*. References T.O. 00-20-5 and AFRC supplement 1 to 00-20-5, *Aero Space Vehicle/Equipment Inspection And Documentation*, T.O. 00-5-1, *Air Force Technical Order System*. This instruction applies to the 419th Logistics Group (LG) and 419th Operations Group (OG) personnel.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

Clarifies procedures for locally manufactured equipment inspection requirements “not” prescribed by technical data or AFOSH standards (**paragraph 1.**). An * indicates revisions from the previous edition.

***1. Procedures for Locally Manufactured Equipment Inspection Requirements “Not” Prescribed by Technical Data or AFOSH Standards:**

1.1. Owning Workcenter:

1.1.1. Coordinates with quality assurance (QA) to establish inspection intervals and criteria.

1.1.2. Provides inspection requirements to QA for coordination and final approval.

1.1.3. Inspects equipment at least every 180 days.

1.1.4. Assigns identification numbers to equipment to facilitate inspection scheduling.

1.2. Quality Assurance:

1.2.1. Assigns local work card numbers.

1.2.2. Publishes AFTO Form 26Ds, **Inspection Work Document**.

2. Equipment. This instruction applies to those items identified in LWC-419 FW-20-1, *Non-Powered Aerospace Ground Equipment Locally Manufactured Equipment Inspection Work Cards*.

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
