This instruction establishes procedures for accomplishing required aircraft document reviews. It implements AFD 21-1, *Managing Aerospace Equipment Maintenance*. The document review ensures accurate data is maintained on the AFTO Form 781A, **Maintenance Discrepancy and Work Document**, AFTO Form 781H, **Aerospace Vehicle Flight Status and Maintenance Document**, AFTO Form 781K, **Aerospace Vehicle Inspection, Engine Data, Calendar Item Inspection and Delayed Discrepancy Document**, and Core Automated Maintenance System (CAMS) for the purpose of planning, controlling and effectively utilizing the assigned aircraft to accomplish the mission of the wing. This instruction applies to the 419th Logistics Group and 419th Operations Group.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision adds paragraph 2.2.4. Document reviews are accomplished on a TDY that is at least 2 days in duration. A (I) indicates revisions from the previous edition.

1. Responsibilities. Crew chief or assistant crew chief, dock chief, assistant dock chief, or flight chief reviews and verifies the 380 screen, automated records check (ARC), on line CAMS products, and 781 binder are in agreement. Forms are hand carried to the fighter squadron support section, maintenance operations center, plans and scheduling and engine management function.

2. Procedures:

2.1. Document reviews are conducted every 30 days.

2.2. Document reviews are accomplished prior to:

2.2.1. Phase inspection.

2.2.2. Depot input.

2.2.3. Permanent or temporary transfer.

2.2.4. TDY (At least 2 days).

2.3. Document reviews are accomplished upon completion of:

2.3.1. Phase inspection.

2.3.2. Depot input.

2.3.3. Acceptance inspection.

2.3.4. TDY (If away from home station more than 14 days).

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
