This instruction establishes guidelines for the management of - 21 equipment. It implements the provisions of AFD 21-1, *Managing Aerospace Equipment Maintenance*. It applies to all maintenance and aircrew personnel assigned to the 919th Special Operations Wing (919 SOW) and implements AFSOCI 21-105.

**SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

**\*1. GENERAL.** The - 21 section will be responsible for:

- 1.1.** Maintaining - 21 equipment.
- 1.2.** Performing annual inventories of - 21 equipment IAW AFSOCI 21-105.
- 1.3.** Controlling - 21 equipment not installed on the aircraft.

**2. RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**2.1.** Crew chiefs will accomplish a daily inventory and control of - 21 equipment installed on the aircraft while at home station and cross country. The AFSOC Form 31, **Aircraft - 21 Equipment Inventory** will be used to annotate - 21 quantity changes. If discrepancies are discovered annotate AFTO Form 781A, Maintenance Discrepancy and Work Document, and notify - 21 section immediately or upon return to home station.

**2.2.** On deployments, Senior Maintenance Officer shall appoint primary and alternate individuals as - 21 equipment managers in accordance with AFSOCI 21-105, paragraph 1.2.

**2.3.** Aircraft commander or designated aircrew representative has supervisory and custodial responsibility of aircraft - 21 equipment while in control of aircraft. (AFSOCI 21-105, paragraph 6.2)
