This instruction implements AFPD 21-1, *Managing Aerospace Equipment Maintenance*. It establishes the responsibility for the accountability and maintenance of assigned F-16C/D equipment. It applies to all maintenance activities within the 944th Fighter Wing.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision changes the office of primary responsibility (OPR) and updates references (**Attachment 1**). An asterisk (*) indicates revisions from previous edition.

1. Responsibilities. The 302d Fighter Squadron Maintenance (FSM) Plans, Scheduling and Documentation Section is responsible for scheduling the use of maintenance safety and protection equipment; alternate mission equipment (AME) not specified in 944 FWI 21-117, *Maintenance Accountability, Control and Storage of Weapons Alternate Mission Equipment (AME)*; and crew and passenger support equipment for assigned aircraft. The 944th Maintenance Squadron (MXS) Munitions Control is responsible for scheduling the use of weapons AME assigned to the Armament Systems Section. The applicable workcenter is responsible for maintaining and documenting the AFTO Form 95, **Significant Historical Data**.

2. Procedures:

2.1. The 302 FSM is responsible for the items listed in Technical Order (T.O.) 1F-16C-21, *Equipment Inventory List*, Section 1, items 1-1 through 1-18; Section 2, items 2-6, 2-21 through 2-23; and Section 3, items 3-1 through 3-2.

2.2. The 944 MXS is responsible for items listed in T.O. 1F-16C-21, Section 2, items 2-1 through 2-5; 2-7 through 2-10; 2-12; 2-14 through 2-17; and 2-20.
