This instruction establishes procedures for decentralized equipment documents by positioning selected documents in shops maintaining the corresponding equipment. It implements AFRPD 21-1, *Managing Aerospace Equipment Maintenance*. This instruction applies to maintenance activities in the 944th Fighter Wing.

**SUMMARY OF REVISIONS**

This revision incorporates text format change, revises para 1, 1.1, and updates reference publications in Attachment 1. A (I) indicates revisions from previous edition.

**1. Procedures.** Decentralized equipment records will be maintained in accordance with AFRCI 21-101, *Aircraft Maintenance Guidance and Procedures*, and T.O. 00-20-1, (Section II), *Preventative Maintenance Program, General Policy Requirements and Procedures*.

1.1. Automated significant historical data equipment history will be used. Decentralized offices will maintain a current Core Automated Maintenance System (CAMS) printed copy on file of automated AFTO Form 95, **Significant Historical Data**. Plans, scheduling, and documentation will use this hard copy during periods of loss of computer database, temporary duty deployments, and semiannual inspections.

1.2. The owning work center is responsible for maintaining the significant historical data records.

**2. Responsibilities:**

2.1. Decentralized equipment records will be maintained by the following owning work centers for applicable support equipment and alternate mission equipment:

2.1.1. Aerospace Ground Equipment Flight (AGE).

2.1.2. Propulsion Flight.

2.1.3. Accessory Maintenance Flight.

2.1.4. Specialist Flight.

2.1.5. Munitions Flight.

2.2. The maintenance documentation section supervisor will provide assistance upon request and conduct visits semiannually in accordance with AFRCI 21-101.
