This instruction implements AFPD 21-1, *Managing Aerospace Equipment Maintenance*. It provides instruction for assignments of manual job control numbers. This instruction applies to all maintenance activities within the 944th Fighter Wing.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision changes the office of primary responsibility (OPR); updates references (Attachment 1); and reorganizes and updates the job control number listing (Attachment 2). An asterisk (*) indicates revision from previous edition.

1. Responsibility. The 944th Fighter Wing supervision is responsible for ensuring compliance with this directive.

2. Procedures. Attachment 2 of this instruction contains job control numbers for the following conditions:

2.1. When the base level computer is not available and manual backup procedures are necessary.

2.2. When manual documentation is necessary for any scheduled maintenance with a frequency of less than 30 days or 50 operational hours.

2.3. Any 944th Logistics Group Quality Assurance generated inspection.

2.4. For specific occurrence inspections.
