This supplement implements and extends guidance of Air Force Reserve Instruction (AFRCI) 36-2811, 15 August 1997.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

2.3. (Added-944FW) The Chief, Information Systems Flight (944 CF/SCB) is the project monitor responsible for publicizing, proofing and forwarding nominations.

4.1. (944FW) Submit nominations to 944 CF/SCB no later than 15 November. The 944 CF/SCB establishes a board when more than one nomination in the same category is submitted. The board will consist of one senior NCO from within the 944 FW or 944 MSS, 944 OG, and 944 LG.

5.4. (944FW) The 944th Communications Flight Commander will appoint a project officer to submit the unit for this organizational award when justification/eligibility warrants.

6.2. (944FW) The senior managers of the Communication Flight will manage this program for their respective AFSCs.

6.3. (944FW) Save AF Form 1206 to a 3.5-inch diskette. All nominations will be submitted to the Information Systems Flight office (944 CF/SCB) not later than close of business (COB) Sunday of the December Unit Training Assembly (UTA). The selection board will meet during the January UTA, if required.
